	We don't "nickel and dime" families with book fees, athletic fees, electronic device fees, or dress code fees.
FINANCIAL AID	We offer need-based financial aid to all qualified families. You may apply for financial aid at the same time that you apply for admission, but this must be through the Blackbaud website at the link below. Financial aid decisions will not be considered without required documentation (W-2 and 1040's). The deadline is typically April 15th, but a financial aid application can be completed at any time.

CONGREGATIONAL SUPPORT	Many Lutheran high schools across the nation are owned and operated by an association of congregations. With the help of local Lutheran Church Missouri Synod (LCMS) congregations, the Lutheran High School Association (LHSA) was incorporated in Southeast Michigan more than 75 years ago (1944). Since then, LHSA schools have provided a Christian education for more than 15,000 students!
