DESCRIPTION

Lutheran Westland is a college preparatory High School, grades 9-12, located in Westland, Michigan. Established in 1986, Lutheran Westland is one of the best high schools in the area for families searching for the combination of a Christian worldview, co-education, strong academics, excellent faculty, and abundant leadership opportunities in daily student life, clubs, and athletics.

CURRICULUM

The academic program is a college-prep curriculum organized on a semester based eight period daily schedule. All students take seven or eight credits per year. Class periods meet for 45 or 40 minutes each day. There are 181 school days each year.

- **AP courses** are offered in Calculus AB, U.S. History, U.S. Government, Microeconomics, Biology, Chemistry, English Language & Composition, English Literature & Composition. Students also take an "Exam Only" option for courses not offered.

RANK

Rank in class includes all semester grades from all courses for grades 9-12. The ranking is based on the weighted cumulative GPA. Advanced Placement courses will be weighted an additional 1.0 (i.e. A is worth 5.0, a B is worth 4.0, etc.)

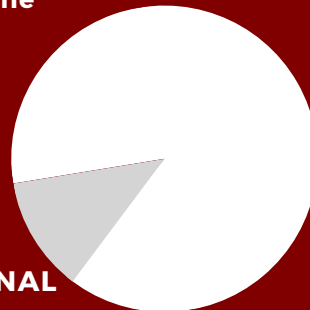

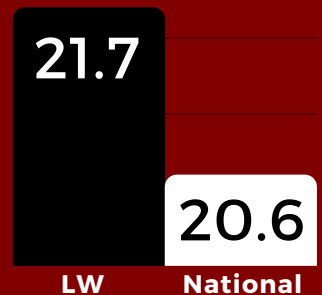
- 56% of students earned at least one academic scholarship
